The following constitute the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

This bill eliminates the state reimbursement to school districts for the tuition costs of children whose parents are employed by the federal government and reside on national parks or monuments in the state. It also eliminates a tuition reimbursement by the Department of Aeronautics for the children of parents who reside on state-owned airfields. Lastly, the bill eliminates the reimbursement by cities to parents residing on tax exempt airfields.' The students affected by the bill are all already and will continue to be counted in the state aid to schools formula.
