Legislative Bill 839 eliminates Nebraska Department of Education tuition payments to school districts educating children of nonmilitary federal employees residing in national parks or national monuments within the state (Section 79-447). It also eliminates Department of Aeronautics tuition payments to school districts educating children of parents residing on state owned airfields (Section 79-446.01), and city tuition payments to school districts educating children of parents residing on city-owned airfields (79-446.02).
