This bill authorized the creation of joint public agencies and provides duties to the Secretary of State. In addition, LB 87 allows for the creation of interlocal entities between various governmental subdivisions.

The Secretary of State's Office feels that any fiscal impact will be negligible and can be accommodated within their existing budget.

According to the Department of Revenue, the fiscal impact will depend on the interlocal entities that would take advantage of this act. The Property Tax Administrator estimates the need for 1.0 FTE in fiscal year 1999-00 and 9.0 FTEs in fiscal year 2000-01 to administer the provisions of LB 87.
