INTRODUCER'S STATEMENT OF INTENT

LB 511

The following constitute the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 511 would allow county boards to designate as a scenic river all or a portion of any river or stream. The county board could adopt or amend zoning regulations for the preservation, protection, and enhancement of scenic river corridors. The designation would include the river or stream and all land within the county which is within one-half mile of either side of the designated reach of the river or stream. Currently, counties do not have the authority to designate scenic river corridors under Nebraska law.
