INTRODUCER'S STATEMENT OF INTENT

The following constitute the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

Legislative Bill 719 is introduced as a vehicle to discuss and address needed revisions in the school affiliation provisions adopted in LB 259 (1990). There is a need to make changes which will facilitate (1) implementation of affiliation (2) the transition from nonresident high school tuition and (3) accomplishment of the stated goal to have all property and students in school systems offering education on a kindergarten through grade twelve basis.
