Summary of purpose and/or changes: LB 595 amends Nebraska law dealing with the election of board of education members in Class III school districts.

Section 1. Amends section 32-543 (2) to allow the members of the board of education of a Class III school district to be nominated by district or ward and elected at large. Currently the members are to be nominated and elected at large or by district or ward. The change is permissive.
